Directions: From Wadebridge town centre, go past the cinema and take the road to Burlawn and Hustyns. The entrance should be arrowed. If you reach the windmills you have gone too far.

Definition: A number of laps of wooded tracks. The number of laps and lap times will be available at the start control. There will be timed tests on some of the laps, more details in the final regs. For further advice please see the current ACU handbook.

Eligibility: Riders must hold and produce on the day a 2019 ACU or SACU licence (if you require a One Event Licence to be issued on the day you will need to send £15.00 with your entry fee) and be aged 16 years or over.

Classes: Please be careful to fill out correctly

Expert *(Any Expert) White numbers on **Green** background*

Over 40 Expert Vets *(Must be at least 40 on day of the event) White numbers on Green background*

Clubman E1 *(100cc - 125cc two stroke and 175cc - 250cc four stroke)*

Clubman E2 *(140cc - 250cc two stroke and 290cc - 450cc four stroke)*

Clubman E3 *(290cc - 500cc two stroke and 475cc and over four stroke) All Clubman classes, black numbers on **Yellow** backgrounds*

Over 40 Clubman Vets *White numbers on **Blue** background*

Novice/Sportsman *(for genuine novices or the very old!) White numbers on **black** background*

Entries: Online at www.acu.org.uk Written entries MUST be on the correct ACU headed entry form, show the event details and permit number and be completed in every detail and signed by the rider (N.B. a requirement of signing an entry application entry form is that each signatory understands the National Sporting Code of the ACU. It must be returned to the Secretary of the event with the correct entry fee (cheques payable to the Camel Vale MCC). Final regs. and a list of riders will be put on www.camel-valemcc.net. There will **not** be a reserve list, acceptance of late entries or requests for entry by phone/email. Entry will be limited and by order of receipt. **The entry will CLOSE when deemed full or Saturday 28 September 2019**

Tyres: **FIM APPROVED TRIALS TYRE TO THE REAR ONLY, NO MOTOCROSS OR ENDURO TYRES.** Front tyre choice optional

Helmets: Helmets bearing the Gold or Silver stamp, in sound condition and properly fitted must be worn by all competitors.

Clothing: As per current Enduro Regulations

Numbers: **Front and side panels must be the same colour**

Machine examination and Signing On: 0800 – 0930 strictly. You must present your machine and clothing/helmet for inspection.

Disqualification: We will not tolerate excessive noise, refuelling anywhere other than in an allocated area, smoking in the pits (competitor, or your mechanic or crew), children or pets in the pits and also excessive speed in a blue taped area. **Blue tape means walking pace or slower.** We will disqualify anyone course cutting or abusing officials.

N.B. The ACU National Sporting Code section 6.06.8

The clerk of the course may at his own discretion

Order any rider to be flagged off the course at any time during a practice or race whom he considers for any reason to be a potential source of danger, or whom he considers is in breach of racing discipline or the sound control regulations.

Non Starters: Any entrant who does not sign on will only be refunded with advice as to reason for non entry and provided that we receive this within **24 hours**.

Fire Extinguishers: All competitors with the exception of those travelling to an event on the machine on which they are competing, must have a 2kg (minimum) dry powder fire extinguisher available for immediate use at any refuelling point.

Power Washers: Use of power washers is prohibited.

Toilets and a catering van will be provided

Please note that the woods are closed for the duration of the event to spectators.

ENTRY DECLARATION: I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -

- I declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so.
