Course: Three classes available (Expert and Clubman) who will each complete a predetermined number of laps (eg 11 & 10) which equals approx 2hrs, laps may be amended on the day after consideration of weather conditions. Everyone will be allowed reasonable time to complete their number of laps. The course will be approximately 4 miles in length with both woodland and field boundaries, and include at least 3 observed sections per lap. The Riders will start in pairs and in numerical order at 30 sec intervals. Penalties will be incurred as follows - 1 penalty point for every 30 sec slower than the rider who sets standard time in each class plus marks lost in observed sections (1 2 3 & 5). Ties will be decided on clean sections.

Entries: Can be completed online at www.acu.org.uk. There will not be any paper/postal entries. Final regulations and the list of rider numbers with start times will be published on www.camel-valemcc.net. (N.B. a requirement of entry application is that each entrant understands the National Sporting Code of the ACU)

There will not be any acceptance of late entries.

Entry will be limited to the first 80 riders by order of receipt. The entry will close when complete or on Saturday 18 September 2021.

Entry Fee : £30.00 (CVMCC membership to December 2021: £7)

Eligibility: Open to riders who hold a 2021 ACU Trials Registration (if you have an competition licence please make sure you have trials registration added to it- this does not cost any extra) and are **aged 16 years or over**. All entrants aged 16 and 17 must have a parent/responsible adult at the event and to sign on with them.

Machine/clothing examining and signing on: 11.15 to 12.15am strictly. You must present your bike to the machine examiner prior to signing on. Also your helmet in sound condition and properly fitting (Gold Stamp advisable), and protective clothing as ES13 of the ACU Standing Regulations.

All machines must have FIM approved Trials tyres as per ACU Trials regs to the rear. Strictly no motocross or enduro tyres to the rear. Front tyre optional.

Blue Tape means walking pace and crossed arrows indicate a hazard.

Exclusions: We will not tolerate excessive noise; refuelling anywhere other than in an allocated area; smoking, children or pets in the pits; excessive speed in a blue taped area and course cutting or abusing officials.

A list of riders will be published on the club website the week prior to the event or once the entry has shut.

N.B. The ACU National Sporting Code section 6.02.2

The clerk of the course may at his own discretion (h) Order any rider to be flagged off the course at any time during a race whom he considers for any reason to be a potential source of danger, or whom he considers is in any breach of racing discipline or the sound control regulations.

Non Starters: Any entrant who does not sign on will only be refunded if written advice as to reason for non entry is received within 7 days of the event.

UNAUTHORISED RIDING ON THE FARMLAND / CAMPING AREA WILL RESULT IN YOUR EXCLUSION FROM THE EVENT.
